




A large number of children participated in this year's art competition. The entries will be displayed on the video in tonight's program. Winners will also be declared and prizes will be given.

Diwali - My Favourite Festival

Diwali is the biggest Indian festival. It is celebrated in the month of Kartik according to the Hindu calendar which falls in the month of October/November every year. Diwali is also called "Festival of Lights" which signifies the victory of light over darkness.

Diwali is celebrated for many reasons. One of them is to commemorate the day when Lord Rama returned to his kingdom after his battle with the Demon King Ravana. The day Lord Rama returned, it was a moonless night. The people of Ayodhya lit diyas (small oil lamps) all over the Ayodhya. Some others believe that it is Goddess Lakshmi's birthday.

Diwali is a festival which many people around the world celebrate with lights, earthen lamps, candles, fireworks and sweets. It is celebrated over a five day period:

1. Dhanteras:

The first day of Diwali is called Dhanteras. People offer prayers to Goddess Lakshmi (Goddess of Wealth) and Lord Ganesha. In some parts, people pray to Dhanvantri, as well.

2. Little Diwali:

The second day of Diwali is called Choti Diwali. This day is associated with the defeat of the demon king Narakasura by Lord Krishna, who freed 16,000 captive women reminding not to abuse our power and use our strength for good cause.

B. Diwali:

The third day of Diwali falls on the moonless night (Amavasya). This is the main festival day. This day is also celebrated as the New Year day.

Govardhana Puja:

The fourth day is associated with reconciliation and forgiveness. On this day, Lord Krishna is worshipped with offerings of food arranged in the form of Govardhana, a hill in Vrindavana city.

5. BhaiyaDuj:

The fifth and the last day of the celebrations, is dedicated to celebrating the relationship between a brother and a sister. According to one legend, on this day, Lord Krishna after slaying Narakasura, a demon, goes to his sister Subhadra's home who welcomes him with a lamp, flowers and sweets, and puts a holy protective tika on Lord Krishna's forehead.

Diwali is a time of happiness and love which I think should be shared by everyone. I and my friends look forward to receive gifts on the Diwali Day.




